**Load Limit:** Items will be limited to one vehicle load per family. If you are assisting a neighbor in need please pre-register with the Community by June 3/2014 in order to bring in additional loads.

## No commercial vehicles permitted.

City of Calgary: Waste Trucks will be on hand from 9 AM - 2 PM. Before you send items to the landfill, consider whether you can sell, donate, repair or recycle them.

**Not accepted:** No hazardous goods, paint, household chemicals, tires, refrigerators, freezers, washers, dryers, dishwasher, propane tanks, car batteries, glass, liquids or large furniture.

**Organics:** The City of Calgary will be on hand to collect organic waste which includes brush, grass clippings, leaves, branches, clean fill (dirt free of rocks), tree trimmings, and general yard waste that can be composted.

Not accepted: Sod will not be accepted as organic waste.

Electronic recycling: era (electronic recycling association) will be on site and accepting for donation and recycling: Desktops—PC & MAC partials, parts, motherboards, Notebooks/laptops/tablets. PC & MAC docking stations, parts, cables, etc. Printers, inkjet & laserjet plotters/copiers, scanners/fax, keyboard, mouse, CD/DVD roms, cards/accessories, servers-rack mount & stand alone. Phone Systems, voicemail Nortel/lucent, parts/accessories, mobile phones, chargers, headsets. Monitors & TVs—CRT & LCD Plasma, projection. Software -operating systems, editing, design. Racks & misc. -server racks, lab equipment, disk arrays. Cisco networking, switches, routers.

**Not accepted:** LARGE CRT TV's and large floor standing printer/copiers.

The City of Calgary Animal & Bylaw Services: will be in the community that day, please drop by and ask any questions that you may have. You can contact Animal & Bylaw Services at 311.

**Trash to treasure Tent**—each year volunteers do their best to re-claim items destined for the landfill. Many residents have benefited from used furniture, toys, garden items and décor. Items are can be taken for a small donation with a limit of 3 per household.
